Full Fee Payment Receipt & Learning Agreement Confirmation of Enrollment Student joins EAHM Facebook – Orientation Week Group (invitation will be sent via email) Student receives and submits "Visa Application and Arrival Information Forms" Admissions Officer confirms course selection – approved learning agreement sent to home university Registrar / International offices (see EAHM Calendar for Add / Drop Period Dates) Student receives go-ahead from the Admissions Officer to book flights (subject to Visa confirmation from the UAE Immigration Department) – Arrival only in Dubai Int. 	The Industry Liaison Department will arrange the Internship prior to completing the Academic Trimester, if the home university requires it and will contact the student via email prior to arrival with the confirmation. Salary for the internship may be paid and ranges between USD270 – USD500 per month (in addition to duty meals). Duration of the Internship is recommended for at least 4 months .
