- (2) Students who demonstrate excellent academic performance and personal integrity
- (3) Students who do not intend to obtain a degree at Ibaraki University
- (4) Students who have definite purpose and plan for studying with the aim to benefit from this online program
- (5) Students who are still registered as full-time registration at the partner university during their participation in this online program.

An exchange student from a partner university is accepted as "Special Auditor" at Ibaraki

University.

- All the materials should be submitted as electric data attached to email. There is no need to send the original files by post. Please make a password for the materials if necessary.
