APPLICATION PROCEDURE INFORMATION

Nomination Process: partner institution to send nomination details by email (name, email, start month, duration, subject area & level of study while at NU) to bc.exchangeapplicantservices@northumbria.ac.uk

Each nominated student will receive individual email instructions on how to apply online and partner institution will be copied into the email.

Nomination Deadlines:

Semester 1 (September) –1st April 2024 Semester 2 (January) – 1st October 2024

Application Deadlines: students to complete online application and submit all supporting documents (ie: passport, English qualification, recent academic transcript and if required, portfolio.

Semester 1 (September) – 15 April 2024 Semester 2 (January) – 15 October 2024

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

English presessional course - details about studying English with NU before starting your exchange studies.

<u>English Requirements</u> - the following minimum requirements are generally for undergraduate non final year exchange study.

IELTS: overall 6.0 (with minimum of 5.5 in each component) **TOEFL IBT**: overall 79 (with minimum R18, W17, L17, S20)

Dual Degree:

IELTS: overall 6.5 (with minimum of 5.5 in each component) is equivalent to **TOEFL IBT:** overall 89 (with minimum R18, W17, L17, S20)

Acceptable English Qualifications - find out about recognised English tests, any acceptable country specific qualifications and relevant exemptions.
